High Quality OEM Type Replacement Speakers For The 1984-1988 Pontiac Fiero

By now, most all Fiero factory speakers have disintegrated foam causing rattling and vibration. Rodney Dickman decided that new OEM type speakers were needed to replace the original units.

While you can find 4" x 10" (fronts) and 4" x 6" (rears) in the market place, typically a major name brand will cost \$80 to \$150 (or more) per pair. These custom made speakers are only \$59.95 per pair for the fronts and \$57.95 per pair for the rears. The speakers are dual cone, 8-ohm fronts and 4-ohm rears. After listening to many opinions on what ohms to use, Rodney elected to go with 8-ohms in the front and 4-ohms in the rear. Factory speakers are 10-ohms for the front speakers and 4-ohms for the rear speakers. 8-ohms in the front is a compromise for factory radios and aftermarket radios.

A major speaker manufacturer manufactures these speakers. Original speakers were sent to the manufacturer and they used them to make these custom speakers. Rodney (as usual!) insisted on top quality components. They should easily exceed the quality of the factory GM original speakers.
